

Admission Requirements

- 1) Completion of PH 101 and PH 102. Grade of C or better is required (not C-). Overall GPA minimum of 2.0.
- 2) Upon completion of PH 101 and PH 102, admission to the BSPH is automatic for students admitted to UNM on or after fall 2020. Students must be in pre-PH status. Student admitted to UNM before fall 2020 must submit an online application at coph.unm.edu.
- 3) Meet with COPH undergraduate advisor. Make appointment on LoboAchieve. Email: dnoriegalucero@salud.unm.edu

The following requirements must also be met

- 1) A total of 42 credits of upper division courses (300-level or 400-level)
- 2) The MD track requires a CHEM minor of 20cr.
- 3) At least 120 credits to graduate.
- 4) All other University requirements as stated in the Catalog
- **The BSPH cannot be added as a second major to any degree program
- **A grade of C (not C-) is needed for all courses to satisfy the UNM Core and the PH Core.
- **MD-Track students are encouraged to complete 4 semesters of clinical experience in preparation for medical school application.
- **Check with the SOM to which you intend to apply to for specific admissions requirements to their MD program.
